After Ryan Whalen gave the ball a huge ride to start the game, the defense allowed no punt return. Connestoga went 3 plays and then punted with no return from MCE. On first down, Cody Pascale had a 15 yard run, then another 10 yard run to get the ball to the 5 yard line. On 4th and 2, Cody ran the ball to the left for a TD. Mac Gallagher ran the ball in for the point after.

Ryan Whalen had another very deep kick and the kicking team only allowed a return of 5 yards. Michael Bradley made a great tackle in the backfield which forced a punt.
