

Pennridge Greenjackets 90-3, 13, Marsh Creek Eagles 90-2, 12 - The 90-2, Marsh Creek Eagles lost a hard fought game to the Pennridge Greenjackets 90-3, team on a beautiful early September day for football. The extra point attempt failed, as Ryan Wetzel stopped the play in the back field. The score was 13-12, Pennridge. After trading possessions again, Marsh Creek needed the ball back to have a chance to score; the Marsh Creek defense came up big with key tackles made by Tanner Troffo, Sean Sweeney, Ryan Wetzel and Ricky Cahill. Unfortunately, the last Marsh Creek drive ended on the Pennridge 15 yard line as time ran out on a great day for football.
