

**Bensalem, PA** – The Marsh Creek Eagles (Eagles) 90 pound #2 Team faced the Bensalem Ramblers (Ramblers) at 1:00 pm on what turned out to be a beautiful sunny 70 degree Sunday afternoon. The team captains for this week's game were Eric Grintz, Adam Grintz, and Donald Hicks. The starting offense consisted of Donald Hicks, Andrew Kessler, Domenic Massimo, Ryan Wetzel, Michael Toler, Sean Sweeney, Scott Jewett with a mixed and matched backfield of Eric Grintz, Dalton Pascale, Michael Mullen, and Tanner Troffo. The "Eagle" and "Steeler" defenses consisted of Jake Gise, Ryan Wetzel, Adam Grintz, Dalton Pascale, Andrew Ciliberto, Samuel Liberati, Scott Jewett, Zachary Burdenski, Ethan Renn, Tanner Troffo, Richard Cahill, and Grayson Weaver.

The Eagles won the coin toss and took possession of the ball to open the first quarter. The opening drive stalled after four plays and the Eagles had to punt.

The Ramblers first drive was slowed down by a nice solo tack for a four yard loss by Adam Grintz on the Ramblers 40 yard line. On the next play, Zachary Burdenski intercepted the Ramblers pass to shut down the initial drive.

On the Eagles second drive the offensive line started to click and the Eagles backfield picked (Grintz, Troffo, and Pascale) up gains of 15, 8, 30, and 5 yard gains. Ethan Renn and Adam Grintz stopped the Rambler runner on second possession of the first half, forcing the Ramblers to punt. Another defensive highlight of the second half was a viscous sack of the Rambler quarterback by Ethan Renn, Andrew Kessler, and Scott Jewett forcing the Ramblers to punt yet again.

Richard Cahill stopped a pass play by the Ramblers in the fourth quarter, thwarting any Rambler comeback. The game ended with score, the Marsh Creek Eagles 6 and the Bensalem Ramblers 0. The Eagles record moved to 2-1-1, with next weeks game against the Methacton Wolverines.
